

Local Church to Feature Prominent Christian Evangelists This Month

Former Homosexual/Transgender will Describe His Former Life and Path Out of it Through the Grace of God

Coach Dave Daubenmire is Scheduled to Make Guest Appearance

WOODLAND, Maine - Intervention C.R.P. Church, a/k/a Carson Road Pentecostal Church in Woodland will be hosting two Christian guest speakers on January 29 at 6pm.

David Arthur, founder of I Belong Amen Ministries will recount his former days as a confused homosexual/transgender and how he was led out of that life by Christ. Coach Dave Daubenmire, founder of Pass the Salt Ministries, is a nationally-acclaimed, highly energetic and inspiring Christian Evangelist. He is also scheduled to speak at the event. Coach Dave, a veteran 35 year high school football coach, was spurred to action when attacked and eventually sued by the ACLU in the late 1990's for mixing prayer with his coaching. After a two year battle for his 1st amendment rights and a determination to not back down, the ACLU relented and offered coach an out of court settlement.

On January 29, there will be a morning prayer meeting at the Pentecostal church on Currier Street in Fort Fairfield at 8am. The main event will be at Intervention Church in

Woodland, starting at 6pm and a morning prayer meeting will follow the next day at Reno's Restaurant in Caribou at 8am. Both Daves will be producing their online radio shows from the prayer meeting locations. See complete schedule of events on page three of this issue of FFJ.

"This could be a busy week," said event organizer, Bob Roy. "The truth from these two speakers will set us free!"

David Arthur was sexually abused from around the age of 5. He contracted HIV/AIDS at age fourteen. In his early adult years he engaged in a sexually perverted life, transgender prostitution, drug addiction, gambling, alcoholism and more. In 2009, at the age of 37 he was on his deathbed. He was so far gone that the doctors sent him home to die, giving him less than 3 months to live.

Afraid to die and not wanting to go to hell, Arthur hit rock bottom and turned to Jesus. He prayed for weeks, repenting/confessing of all his sins - in detail,

as he prepared for death. Jesus heard his cry and delivered him. One day David woke up with an incredible Peace inside, what he calls his "Moment of Grace". A Peace like he had never experienced. He was free of sin that held him captive! He still believed he was going to die, but was no longer afraid of death and knew that he was not going to hell. He was at Peace with himself, because he knew, without a shadow of a doubt, that he was Forgiven. David prayed that through his death others would come to know JESUS.

Jesus not only rescued Arthur from the captivity of his addictions, but freed him from physical & spiritual death. He is healthy and strong, today and eager to share his message of redemption through his ministry.

"Using myself as an illustration, as a former homosexual, and former transgender person, with decades of experience in that world, I can say without a shadow of a doubt that homosexuality (including transgenderism) is absolutely mutable and curable," said Arthur. "God has Created each one of us in a heterosexual design which cannot be altered, regardless of what lies, or sin, we embrace. We are born male or female. Our DNA makes us male or female and no surgery in the world can change our DNA. Changing our sex/gender is not possible."

Contemplating suicide and dealing with his previous molestation. Arthur was living a life doomed and littered with drugs, alcohol, and prostitution. "It was a correctional officer that reached me, with Truth, in Love," he said.

Arthur speaks to the confusion caused by the gender dysphoria controllers who seek to muddle the minds of society with errant and self-destructive behavior that goes against all natural processes. "Sex means biological sex and its definition did not change because someone suffers from a disorder (although we know this is 'sin', it is a mental disorder, confusion). Each of us is born with a race, a color, a sex, and a nationality. Sex is objective, not subjective, and binary — either male or female. Gender dysphoria is confusion, and that would fall under the "mental disorder" category and not the sexual orientation one. It would not be called deception if one knew they were being deceived," he explains. "When a male begins identifying as a female then that male is no longer mentally stable. To enter into the 'transgender' world one must undergo, and continue in, extensive mental health counseling, and that fact alone says that the individual is not mentally stable. The suicide rate amongst transgenders increases with

the hormone treatment and even more so with the surgery. We cannot change the meaning of words just because a very small population of mentally unstable individuals "feel" they want to be what they are not."

Arthur will share details of this life and transition at the Intervention Church meeting on January 29 at 6pm.

Coach Dave Daubenmire is also scheduled to join the event. After his out of court settlement with the ACLU, Daubenmire started Pass the Salt Ministries to spread his message on the power of prayer and in following Christ. Pass The Salt was formed to encourage the Body of Christ to step into the cultural war. "For we wrestle not against flesh and blood..." Pass The Salt is convinced that God has given the Body a window of opportunity to take our culture back.

Pass The Salt is committed to bringing together the body of Christ across denominational, racial, and economical borders to demonstrate to America the power of Biblical unity. Our vision is to unite, organize, and mobilize the Army of God to be SALT and Light as stated in Matthew 5:12.

Challenging the "church of the Status Quo", Pass The Salt is calling Christians to engage the culture. By taking the fight to the enemy Coach Daubenmire has become a recognizable voice with the media as he is an unashamed, articulate, apologist for the Christian worldview. Coach's willingness to stand with Judge Roy Moore in Alabama, Terri Schiavo in Florida, and the 10 commandments in Washington DC, has enabled him to partner with some of the nationally known voices in America.

Coach is using his knowledge of education and educational issues to equip Christians to defend the Judeo-Christian worldview. A popular, high-energy speaker, Coach Daubenmire's motivational lectures laced with scripture are challenging Americans all across the country.


